

This workshop is designed for midwives, midwifery students, and medical assistants to learn the basics of venipuncture in a real midwifery practice. These skills are not often needed but can very helpful when circumstances arise that replacement fluids and medications are needed. IV certification is mandated by some jurisdictions for licensure and renewal. This workshop provides the attendees the opportunity to practice the appropriate knowledge, skills and techniques for successful intravenous setup, maintenance, and removal with the careful supervision of a skilled instructor.

Attendees must have a successful I.V. start to obtain certification. Each attendee must be willing to have a supervised I.V. start performed on them or bring a person willing to take their place. This component of the class will be in the last two hours of the workshop.

This workshop includes a pre reading assignment, lecture, visual aids, and models with a strong emphasis on 'hands on' practice with artificial and live models using the included appropriate supplies and equipment.
